INCLEMENT WEATHER: NOTIFICATION OF UNEXPECTED SCHOOL CLOSURE

Just in case the weather takes a turn for the worst in December or January the system for notifying parents is through our ParentMail system. We recognise that bad weather causes considerable disruption and endeavour to keep the school open as much as possible and where it is safe to do so. A decision to shut the school is never taken lightly and many factors contribute to making that decision. Myself and the site management team are in contact very early in the morning in order to assess the site. Should the decision be made to close the school, you will be notified by 7.30am at the latest but in reality it is often earlier than this. The website will also be updated.

Please do NOT ring the school. If we open in bad weather we understand that it will take families longer to get to school so allowance is made for this and registers remain open longer. If we need to amend the timings of the school day, e.g. due to weather/police advice, then we will communicate this with you at the time and in advance.

Polite Reminders Safety:

Pedestrians:

Please always **use the path** when entering or leaving the site and not exit via the car park on foot.

Drivers:

Please park safely and responsibly on the road without obstructing the driveways or access to local residents' properties/ garages . Please park further down the road from the school and avoid, stopping, turning or reversing in front of the school. This is a very busy place for children and adults crossing. Very young children often run or scoot ahead of their parents and we would like to avoid a nasty accident occurring.

Attendance/sickness absence:

If your child is off school, please ring on the first day of absence **<u>BEFORE 9.15am</u>**. If we have not heard from you we will activate our 'First Day Call' procedure. If your child should get sickness and/or diarrhoea then they should be clear for **48 hours** from the last episode, before returning to school.

Punctuality/drop off & collection: The

gates and class doors open at 8.45am each day (15 mins early) to ease congestion. The gates are locked at 9am. We would kindly ask you to be prompt. Latecomers must enter via the main office and provide a valid reason for late arrival (which is a legal duty placed upon schools). At drop off time: KS2 children should say goodbye to their parents in the main playground; please only go around to the class door if you have a message for the teacher. KS1 parents may drop off and collect at the class door (please keep the entrance way clear). Reception parents may come into the class to help settle their child/ make a lunch choice but please leave the site by 9am so that we can secure eth site and begin the day's learning. Many thanks for your cooperation.

Dental/eye appointments

General check ups. These should be booked for outside the school day or during school holidays.

Medical/hospital appointments:

If this occurs during the school day, please let us know in advance and provide us with the letter/ appointment card so that we may copy it for the records. On the day, come to the main office to sign your child out.

Reception: Elgar & Beethoven: It must be nearly Christmas! This week in Reception the children have been so busy; performing our Christmas sing a-long and making mince pies. On Thursday they had a decoration day where everyone enjoyed making lots of decorations including; a Father Christmas paper plates, angels, reindeer, stockings and many more. In Reception, whilst very tired– the children are truly all in the Christmas spirit!

Year 1: This week Y1 have been consolidating their learning on addition and subtraction in the child led learning tasks. In the creative tasks they have been using and applying the techniques learnt this term through studying different artists to their Christmas cards. We hope you love them!

Year 2: This week in Year 2 we have started to write an information book about China. We have also had a great time performing our Christmas concert. The children really worked hard on their concert and sang beautifully . Despite a few nerves they performed well and hopefully everybody enjoyed the performance.

Year 3: Mozart class have had an active week this week. In science, they created their own magnetic games using the force of attraction. These ranged from creating fishing games, racing games or mazes. In history, the class mummified a tomato! They washed it before pulling out it's brains and organs (aka the seeds). It is now covered in our version of natron in order to dry out and the class will look at what happens to it after Christmas. Mozart also had their last ukulele lesson this week and have done absolutely brilliantly learning the songs, including Silent Night (which some of you will have seen in the concert). Y3 were very lucky to have a professional musician come and teach them how to play this instrument; the class learnt a lot and enjoyed it.
